Finding God's Heart for the World" – 3/1 THROUGH 3/29**

Suzie Dell will present this series, which she has just completed in one of her classes. The author, Dr. Tim Harlow started his first preaching ministry in the south suburbs of Chicago in 1990 at a church of 150 people in a heavily unchurched area. Since then, Parkview has grown into a multi-site church on mission, reaching thousands of people every weekend.

The premise of this series is that most of us want to tell others about Jesus, to share our faith. We want to obey Jesus' command to us: "Go into all the world and make disciples." But when it comes to actually engaging in evangelism, we hesitate. We get intimidated, uncertain, or even confused. Sharing our faith should be natural, easy—but it isn't always. Life on Mission offers clear Bible teaching designed to empower people to share their faith with people right in their own neighborhood. Pastor Tim Harlow walks through topics like how to connect with unbelievers, how serving others can open their hearts to the gospel, and how paying attention to our own spiritual growth can strengthen our witness.

The series will run each Sunday during the 10 am welcome hour in the Fellowship Hall beginning March 1 through March 29.

- Each week will provide us with do-able steps and strategies to CONNECT, SERVE, SHARE, GROW, and PRAY
- There will be a 13-18 minute video on the strategy each week.
- There will then be a discussion following each video lesson.

The first week will contain an OVERVIEW and the topic CONNECT. There will be a sign up sheet in the lobby for each week.
