



COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

August 8, 2024

♦Ron Long, Financial Secretary:

Yellow Brick Road Child Care is up to date with payments. The additional room not needed now.

- **◆Chris Arany, Treasurer**: We have had negative net income during June and July. \$7,000 was borrowed from the Memorial Fund and returned after the Capital One CD was cashed.
- **♦Lana Albright, Spiritual Life:** A few members were visited. Membership rolls are being reviewed.
- *Joy Ivins, Worship/Music: Hope was invited to a combined service at Gloria Dei with 3 other congregations on September 22, but we declined to participate at this time. Hope's choir was also asked to join other churches for St. Paul's Community Church's 150th Anniversary

Celebration.

- ♦ Bonnie Long, Generosity: Ron Long stated the Strategic Planning Committee will meet on August 25. The next "Stewardship for All Seasons" is planned for August 15. The appeal Sunday will be in October.
- **◆Carmen Hasdorff, Property:** The drains and gutters were cleaned.
- **→Jerry Ivins, Digital Ministry:** The committee is organizing a video showing various activities for the church website. We have the new church sign and are waiting for hardware to put it in place.
- **◆Pastor Christie**: She was not present due to a death in her family.
- ◆The council passed the motion to accept the memorial gift in memory of K.C. Kless from Rachael Kless and Joan Ritchie in the amount of \$30,000 and to use the gift for renovations and community ministries in the Fellowship Hall. The motion will now be taken to the congregation for a vote.
- ♦ Mike Schweinfest, Interim President: He conducted the council meeting and will assemble a Nominating Committee to find volunteers for Treasurer, Outreach, Christian Education and Fellowship positions.
- ◆The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's prayer.


